Presentation from Police Chief Kevin Jarriel

Mayor and Commissioners reviewed the monthly activity report.

Discussion of GDOT 2025 Local Road Assistance (LRA) Grant of \$42,744.63 for the resurfacing of Lanne Avenue

The City Commission agreed to submit Lane Avenue as the 2025 LRA project.

Discussion of Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision of P-25 Radio System between the Emanuel County Board of Commissioners and the City of Twin City

The City Commission reviewed the IGA and the cost projections for the new radio system for public safety. After discussion, the Commission agreed to enter into the agreement with the Board of Commissioners.

Discussion of Municipal Clerks Week of May 4-10, 2025

Mayor Donaldson proposed declaring May 4-10, 2025 as Municipal Clerks Week in conjunction with the International Institute of Municipal Clerks.

Discussion of GRWA Power Resiliency Project report

The Commission reviewed the report prepared by the Georgia Rural Water Association. It provided recommendations on generator sizes, locations, and types.

Discussion of project update from Service Line Inventory

Mayor Donaldson updated the Commission on the progress of the service line inventory. The previously approved contractor is working in Twin City presently.

Discussion of the compensation of the City Commission

The compensation for the City Commission has not been changed in over 14 years. The Commission reviewed salary data from the DCA on other municipal officials in Georgia from similarly-sized cities. After discussion, the Commission agreed to consider an increase. The Commission is required to run a public notice in the legal organ for (3) consecutive weeks, which will be done in May. The matter will be decided in the June 2025 meeting.

Discussion of vacancy on the Planning Commission of the City of Twin City

Due to death of Planning Commissioner Dewayne Rollins, there is a vacancy on the Planning Commission. Mayor Donaldson asked the City Commission for suggestions on the replacement.
