CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Donaldson

6:30 P.M.

Presentation from Police Chief Kevin Jarriel

Mayor and Commissioners reviewed the monthly activity report.

Discussion of Fire Chief of Twin City Fire Department

Former Chief Chatt Jones voluntarily resigned. Dusty Holden was elected as the new Fire Chief, and the City Commission agreed to his election by the department.

Discussion of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Georgia Department of Transportation and the city of Twin City

Due to inflationary increases, Mayor Donaldson secured additional T-SPLOST funding to complete the T-SPLOST roads of W. Broad Street, Old Swainsboro Road, Parrish Pond Road, 1st Avenue, Wilson Road, and Coursey Road. This supplemental agreement awards the city an additional \$170,000.00 to complete these projects.

Discussion of Change Order No.1 with East Coast Asphalt, LLC for 2025 Paving Improvements

Due to additional funding available, Mayor Donaldson asked the City Commission to consider more roads for resurfacing. This change order adds the following roads: Coleman Road, Hattaway Street, Malsby Street, N. Swift Street, 3rd Avenue, and Church Street. This brings the revised contract to \$1,205,701.79.

Discussion of additional roads for 2025 Paving Improvements

Due to additional funding available, Mayor Donaldson asked the City Commission to consider additional roads up to the maximum budget. Until the funding is exhausted, the following roads, in order, shall be resurfaced: Durden Road, 6th Ave, Oglesby Pond Rd, Bailey St, S. College St Extension, S. Swift St, New St, and Casa Drive.

Discussion of 2026 Occupational Tax Certificate Schedule

The City Commission agreed to maintain business licenses fees at the current levels. The last increase was in 2023.

Discussion of update from FEMA on Hurricane Helene expense reimbursements

The City of Twin City should receive approximately \$38,000.00 from FEMA within the next few weeks. Mayor Donaldson thanked City Clerk Genia Ducker for her hard work in this process.

Discussion of FLOST referendum on November 4, 2025

This measure will be on the November 2025 ballot for the consideration of the voters. If passed, there will be another 1% tax collected. The funds collected will be used to provide property tax relief. The City of Twin City would collect 7.21% of the fund, which matches the population percentage.

Discussion of vacancy on the Planning Commission of the City of Twin City

Due to death of Planning Commissioner Dewayne Rollins, there is a vacancy on the Planning Commission. Mayor Donaldson asked the City Commission for suggestions on the replacement.
