Presentation from Police Chief Hank Whiters.

Chief Whiters stated that Officer Rolando River-Gonzalez no longer works for the City of Twin City, and he has accepted his resignation. Jessica Sumner completed her Municipal Court Clerk training and is now working to complete her GCIC TAC training. Chief Whiters has two applicants he would like the Commission to consider sending to the Police Academy in January.

Discussion of resurfacing/patching project for City streets.

Commissioner Brown had a quote from T&K Hicks with multiple scenarios to consider. The Commission decided to proceed with the resurfacing of Brown Avenue in preparation for the new Piggly Wiggly and patches on Central Street, Mathis Street, and Durden Road for a total of \$36,392.50.

Discussion of 2021 Occupational Tax Certificate Schedule.

Mayor and Commissioners decided to leave the payment schedule the same as last year, but with changing the late from \$50 to \$50/month you are late after January 31st, 2021.

Discussion of City of Twin City Zoning Ordinance revision to add Article XIX- Solar Energy Systems and need for Public Hearing for final revision.

 There was a first reading of the proposed Article XIX to the City of Twin City Zoning Ordinance

Mayor and Commissioners will have a public hearing November 3, 2020 at 6PM.

Discussion of Christopher Stanford Rezoning Public Hearing on Thursday, October 15, 2020 at 6PM at the ECI Auditorium.

The final hearing for the Stanford rezoning request in on October 15, 2020 at 6PM. The City must comply with the Zoning Procedures Law, as well as a separate state law concerning the rezoning for the purposes of locating a halfway house.

Discussion of 2020 millage Rate.

Mayor and Commissioners will approve the 2020 in the November meeting. There was a consensus of the Commission to not consider a tax increase.

Discussion of 2020 Tourism Product Development Grant award of \$8,000 from the Georgia Department of Economic Development.

The TPD team was in Emanuel County and Twin City in December 2019. One of the suggestions from the team was a linear park on the City-owned railroad bed. Mayor Donaldson applied for the grant, which is only available to those TPD communities, and the City has been awarded \$8,000. The plan is for the park to be completed and named for the City Centennial in 2021.

Discussion of Georgia Cities Week- October 4-10, 2020.

For Georgia Cities Week, the Twin City Main Street Program and HTCGA are hosting a City-Wide Clean Up on Saturday, October 10, 2020 starting at 9am. There will be large trash dumpsters at the City Shop, Stitch-N-Print, and Old Brown's Convenience Store (corner of Highway 80 and 192). This is for household garbage only absolutely no tires. The Twin City Police Department will be monitoring for illegal tire dumps.
